## YOUR ROLE

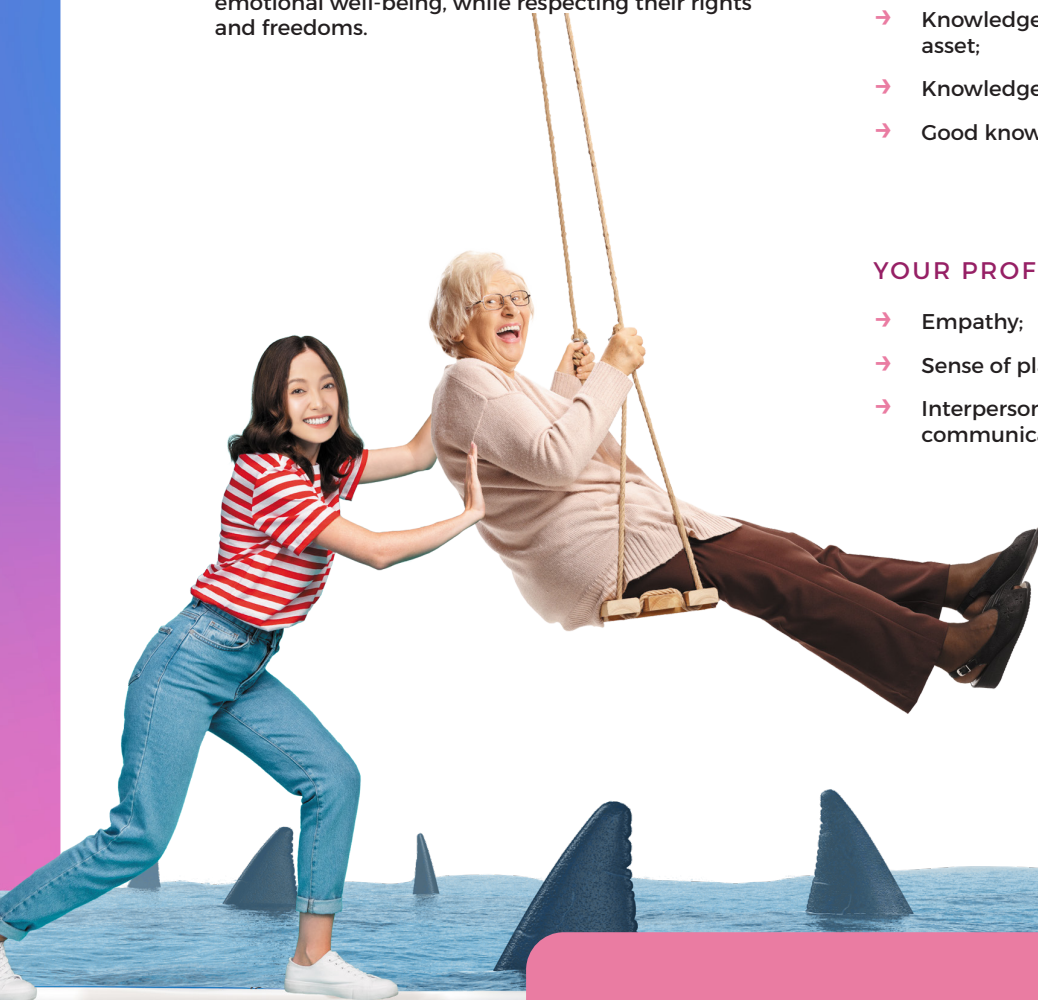
- You will accompany people with Alzheimer's, taking into account their interests, limitations and abilities;
